- Plan Adopted by Tribe
- Currently Under FEMA Review

 - Feasibility Report for Chignik Lake to Lagoon Road (FHWA, 2011)




ADOT&PF Project Scoping (2004)

Chignik Community Plan – Stakeholder Engagement

- Community Plan and THMP, concurrent.
- Working Group Meeting #1 (Jan 2024)
 - Values, Vision, and Critical Issues from 2009
- Public Meeting (Feb 2024)
 - Values, Vision, and Critical Issues
- Public Survey (Mar 2024)
 - Community
 - 9 questions, six respondents.
 - Youth
 - 12 questions, five respondents.



Chignik Community Plan

- Values, Vision, and Critical Issues
- Distilled into the following categories:
 - Economy
 - Education
 - Infrastructure
 - Community
 - Emergency Services
 - Food Security



- Economy
 - Issue: Work though fisheries decline.
 - Strategy: Diversify the local economy.
- Education
 - Issue: School closed in November 2022
 - Strategy:
 - Get families to move into community.
 - Get more families with kids to live in the community
 - Establish a foster program to bring more kids into the community
 - Establish a private school / tutoring program for when student enrolment is too low using public school support systems
 - Establish a private school / tutoring program for when student enrolment is too low public school using a local faith-based organization
 - Establish Sub-regional vocational school



- Infrastructure
 - Issue: Runway in disrepair.
 - Strategy: Work with ADOT&PF to understand process for repairs.
 - Issue: Aging dam
 - Strategy: Continue working with LPB for new dam / hydro project.
 - Issue: Lack of Solid Waste Management Plan / Understanding
 - Strategy: Develop planning document for municipal waste planning and next steps.



- Community
 - Issue: Cultural / Historic preservation needed.
 - Strategy: Develop a local historic society.
 - Issue: Graveyard at capacity.
 - Strategy: Develop a land community land use plan.
 - Issue: Lack of housing for newcomers and aging homes.
 - Strategy: Coordinate with local governments and residents to purchase existing homes and build new homes.
 - Strategy: Work with regional housing authority and faith-based organizations to repair elder homes.



- Community (cont.)
 - Issue: Jobs and workforce lacking in community.
 - Strategy: Train unemployed residents to fill vacant jobs in city and tribal governments
 - Strategy: Promote and develop new industry in the community that aligns with the community's values and visions.
 - Issue: Population decline.
 - Strategy: Perform a study to evaluate issue and provide recommendations.
 - Issue: Exiting faith-based presence diminishing over the years.
 - Strategy: Work with existing and new faith-based organizations to understand how to increase the presence.




- Emergency Services
 - Issue: Community without a VPO or VPSO.
 - Strategy: Work with BBNA to place a VPO or VPSO in the community
 - Issue: Need tsunami shelters.
 - Strategy: Advance PER grant with BIA TRP.



- Food Security
 - Issue: No community store.
 - Strategy: Work with local organizations / residents to establish a new store.
 - Issue: Safeguard subsistence areas
 - Strategy: Coordinate local planning efforts to identify and protect substance areas.




FAVORITE THING ABOUT LIVING IN CHIGNIK


Do you want the School to reopen?




WHAT'S MISSED ABOUT GOING SCHOOL








WHAT WOULD YOU CHANGE AND WHY?









Data Gap Analysis - 2023

- Root cause of low salmon returns
- More accurate weather data specific to Chignik Bay
- Bathymetry of river, lakes, and bay
- Water level monitoring
- Centralized historical flood database
- Sediment transport model
- Updated land ownership maps
- Updated aerial imagery
- Inner transit system feasibility study specific to Chignik region
