

PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK

- (1) 600 SQ FT VELCOME CENTER (2) REFRIGERATED STORAGE UNITS AND FOUNDATIONS

WATER AND SEVER

- 650 LF WATER WAIN EXTENSION
- 150 LF WATER SERVICE
- 200 LF SEVER SERVICE (2) WATER HYDRANTS
- (1) WATER ACCESS POINT

ELECTRICAL.

- BURED ELECTRICAL SERVICE TO WELCOME CENTER, REPRIGERATED CONTAINER UNITS, AND STREET LIGHTS

CML SITE WORK

- + APPROXIMATELY 1020 OU YOS OF FILL
- . LEVEL AND GRADE APPROXIMATELY 110,000 SO FT

Chignik Dock Uplands Improvement



Recent Progress:

- Procured Fork Lift (2023)
- Completed Design Dock Water Line (2023, Awaiting DEC Approval)
- Procurement Engineering Contract Approval

Secured Funds:

- \$299,000 Water Line Design, Fork Life
 Procurement Lighting, Laydown, Waterline
 Construction (Only Partial Construction Funding)
- \$350,000 CDBG For Use to Design infrastructure at the dock
- \$200,000 Denali Commission For use in matching additional federal funds for construction

Estimated Total Cost:

 \$1.6M - \$2.5M+ (Need \$800k or more additional funding). Range of Costs depends on what infrastructure is recommended for development


- Complete design 2024

- Complete engineering for dock uplands improvements Fall 2024-Spring 2024
- Apply for additional construction funds – Fall 2024 (Seeking CDBG Funds - \$800k)

- Select Engineering Contractor-Fall 2024





LPSD Energy Audit and Upgrades

Overview:

- EPA-funding opportunity (Climate Pollution Reduction Grant Program) for energy audit and energy efficiency upgrades to LPSD schools, housing and district office
- LPB applied on behalf on LPSD due to program requirements
- Requested \$5,335,473
- Decision expected Late Fall 2024

LPB Utility Support Collaborative

Overview:

- LPB-supported electric utility collaborative to provide bookkeeping support, operator training and assistance with electric generation and distribution
- Similar concept to ARUC (ANTHC managed water/sewer program) with communities maintaining ownership and local control
- Requesting ~\$915,000 for a 3-year initiative
- Request due May 30th





Denali Commission Applications

- Submitted funding requests for additional funds for LPB Utility Collaborative (\$250,000)
- GIS mapping (Complete GIS Conversion, Parcel Book development, and Addressing system for 16 communities,
- Iliamna Dock (matching funds for PIDP application (\$1.3M for construction of the dock)
- Three projects max were permitted
- Total of 180+ applications were received.
- Date of announcement is estimated to be Fall 2024
